Quarantining: Unvaccinated Close Contact STUDENT and STAFF

The PA Dept. of Health defines Close Contacts as those who are within 6 ft of an infected individual for more than 15 consecutive minutes.

What is the distance between you and the positive case?

LESS THAN 3 FT. Quarantine at home for 10 days

Were both individuals wearing masks consistently and correctly? and seek testing.*





BETWEEN 3-6 FT.

YES

Get tested. Stay home until test results come back and 24 hours have passed since symptoms resolved. Isolate if test is positive.

NO No action needed, remain in school.

Quarantining: Vaccinated Close Contact STUDENT and STAFF

The PA Dept. of Health defines Close Contacts as those who are within 6 ft of an infected individual for more than 15 consecutive minutes.

Do you have symptoms?

YES

Get tested. Stay home until test results come back and 24 hours have passed since symptoms resolved. Isolate if test is positive.

*This chart also applies to individuals with recent COVID infection or proof of antibodies within the past 90 days.

Vaccination is a personal choice that families should make with their healthcare providers. This chart shows the requirements for contact tracing in schools.

Were you more than 3 ft. away from the infected individual AND were you both wearing masks?

NO

If you were closer than 3 ft. or either was unmasked, wear a mask and get tested 2-5 days after exposure.

YES

No action needed, remain in school.
