FREE MEALS AVAILABLE TO WASHINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT CYBER STUDENTS

Dear Washington School District Families,

Washington School District will be offering FREE take home meals through the end of the 2021-2022 school year for students enrolled in the Prexie Cyber Academy. We will provide a complete breakfast and lunch for 5 days that parents or guardians can pick up once a week. All meals for students K-12 will be picked up at the High School Office on Fridays from 12:00 to 1:00. Parents or guardians must sign up using the link: <https://forms.gle/2cMXXNsP57XH5FdG8> providing the name(s), grade(s) and student ID number(s) of the student(s) they are picking up meals for. You must sign up weekly for these meals by Thursday evening at 10:00 pm. The meals you pick up on Fridays will be for the following week for every school day scheduled that week – all free of charge!
